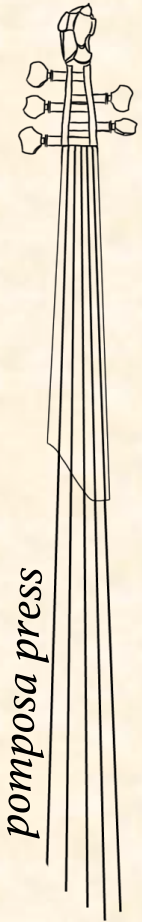

**Instrumentation:** piccolo, 2 flutes, 2 oboes, 2 Bb clarinets, 2 bassoons, 4 French horns, 2 Bb trumpets, 2 tenor trombones, bass trombone, tuba, 3 timpani, percussion (Triangle / Crash Cymbals / Snare Drum / Bass Drum) violin 1, violin 2, viola, cello, bass
